What We Learned

Revamp Summer Orientation (Academic Advising)

Need to identify a method in which incoming students expected credits/courses are documented and in one location for all advisors access

Develop an Onboarding Program

A formal, organized, and structured training program needed to be created for new academic advisors to supplement training already on campus

Centrally Train Prior to Embedding in Department

In order to have consistent training, all new onboarding is be completed in and from the COS Dean's Office Advising Team

Our Approach

Revamp Summer Orientation (Academic Advising)

All incoming students required to complete COS Expected Credits/Courses Form and academic advisors to upload to Navigate

Develop an Onboarding Program

Developed onboarding program for internal/external VT employees. Provides context for academic advising at VT, campus resources, networking with colleagues, academic policies, scenarios, and more!


Centrally Train Prior to Embedding in Department

All new academic advisors are hired in the COS Dean's Office and then embedded in a department. New hires participate in comprehensive 14-business day onboarding program and attend weekly meetings in COS Dean's office

Orientation

Creation of central location for students to upload unoffical transcripts


